LOCATION

Mzuzu, Malawi

PEOPLE SERVED

Infants whose mothers have died during or shortly after childbirth

WHY THERE IS A NEED

Most families can't afford baby formula and other supplies necessary to assure survival of infants.

CURRENT IMPACT

15 residential children, on average

TOTAL IMPACT TO DATE

Nearly 200 orphaned infants

COST OF CARE

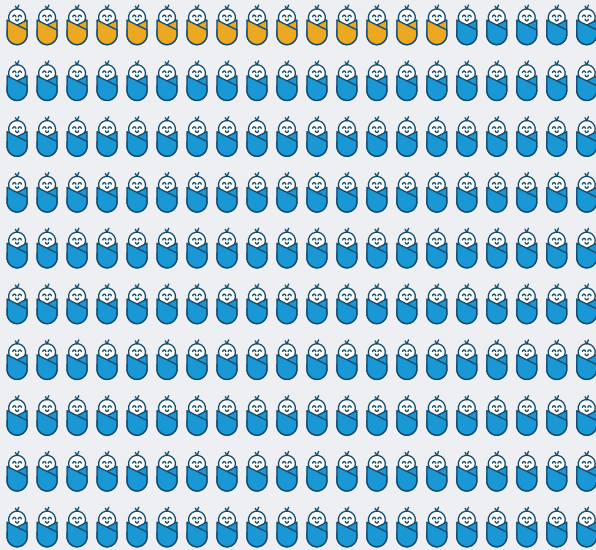
\$250 a month per child which includes baby formula, clothing, caregiver salary, and overhead costs for the building and travel.

MODEL OF CARE

Children typically stay at the Crisis Nursery for 1 to 1 1/2 years. After this, most are returned to extended family who will care for them or to foster care or adoptive families as a permanent placement.

JOB OPPORTUNITIES

Approximately 20 employees, with a focus on helping widows, many of whom would be otherwise unemployed.
